4. Why does God give some believers the particular gifts mentioned in verses 11-12?

5. Where does our church need to grow toward maturity? How can you use the gifts God has given to you to enable this to take place?

6. Read verse 13.
 - a. John Stott writes: "Full unity is also called becoming mature. Some interpret this as individual Christians, which is certainly a New Testament concept, but the context seems to demand we understand it corporately."

 - b. Do these two dimensions' change/confirm the way you think about maturity as a part of the body of Christ?

7. The purpose of the gifts God has given of you is to help you and the church grow in maturity in Christ. In what ways have you experienced this?

8. In what ways are you using your gifts to build up the body?

9. What is the next step you can take to offer or identify your gifts in our church this week?
