The Stronger Challenge is about changing the way our church engages with the world around us. We believe that God will judge our church not on how many we seat, but by how many we send.





Blessing comes only through sacrifice. God calls his leaders, not to a platform to build a great ministry for themselves, but to an altar where they die unto themselves.

This means sending out our best with abandon...Sending and planting is rarely good — in the short run — for our church's attendance or budget bottom line. Of the twenty-five domestic and ninety international churches we have planted, not one has ever contacted us and said,

"We had such a surplus budget this year we wanted to give some back to you!" Church plants are like teenagers — they only want your money and affirmation and then for you to stay out of their way. (Smile.) Sending is costly and painful, but the harvest is a thousand times worth it.
