KEY VERSES

1 Corinthians 9:24-27 Colossians 1:24-29 1 Corinthians 15:58 Psalm 119:112

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1). Colossians 1:29 says, "To this end I strenuously contend with all the energy Christ so powerfully works in me." How can you rely more on God's power rather than your own strength when facing challenges? What are some practical ways you can invite Christ's energy into your daily labor?

2). Colossians 1:26-27 speaks of the mystery now revealed: "Christ in you, the hope of glory." How does knowing that "Christ in you" is your hope of glory impact the way you view your purpose? How can you live out this truth in your everyday life, making Christ's presence in you evident to others?

3). What does it mean to labor "with God" as opposed to laboring "for God"? How do you see this play out in your own life?

4). What are some examples from your life where you've seen God's strength at work through community rather than just through individual effort?

5). In what ways can we help others "get in the game" and discover their own role in the body of Christ?

6). Why is it important to recognize that God has positioned us for impact right where we are? How does this perspective change our daily lives?
