1. What did you learn from this scripture today?

4. The laymen of the church were the ones pushing the boundaries of the church, not relying on the church leaders. Do you push the boundaries of the church, or do you allocate that task to church leaders?
5. The 3 signs of grace: We proclaim the Gospel; We overcome, being more optimistic of grace than pessimistic of sin; We sacrifice for the advance of the Gospel, with joy. How are these three things going in your life? What needs to change?
