Discussion Questions

1. Discuss/ Think about: Where will we enter into the story? Where do our own faith stories resonate with the travelers on the walk to Emmaus? *

Perhaps we recognize the possibility of seeing the face of Christ in every stranger we meet.

We might relate to the disappointment and loss of hope that Cleopas expresses.

Or we might take some comfort in hearing that those closest to Jesus faced challenges in sustaining belief just as we do at times.

We might consider the risk of extending hospitality.

Or, we could spend some time reflecting on the common bond we share with others in every time and place in the breaking of the bread.

We might consider what it would be like to reclaim our love to tell the story of Jesus.

2. Compare the next section of Luke 24 (verses 36-48) with the Emmaus road story. In what ways are they similar?
